



FACTS:

George Washington's original pencil sketch for our nation's flag indicated 6-pointed stars, a form he apparently preferred. Betsy Ross, however, recommended a 5pointed star. When the committee protested that it was too difficult to make, she took a piece of paper, folded it deftly, and with a single snip of her scissors, produced a symmetrical fivepointed star. This seeming feat of magic so impressed her audience that they readily agreed to her suggestion.
